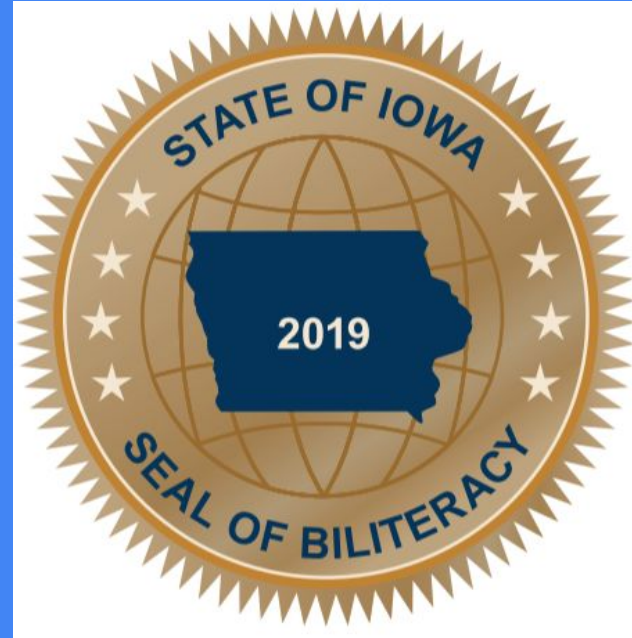

# Seal of Biliteracy

The Seal of Biliteracy is an award by a school, district, or state in recognition of students who have studied and attained proficiency in two or more languages by high school graduation.

# Criterion to earn the seal

- Demonstrate proficiency in the English language
  - Iowa Assessments
  - ELPA21
  - ACT
- Demonstrate proficiency in a World Language
  - STAMP test
  - AP World Language exam

# College Ready Indicators

Academic Indicators GPA of 2.75 and one of the following:

- AP exam score of 3-5
- Grade of a C or higher in an AP course
- Grade of a C or higher in a dual credit English or Math course
- Grade of a C or higher in Algebra II
- Grade of C or higher in four years of English, Math, and Science courses

Or Standardized Test Benchmarks:

- SAT Exam Math (530)/ Reading/Writing (480)
- ACT Exam: English (18)/ Reading (22)/ Science (23)/ Math (22)
- Accuplacer Exam: Reading/Writing (250) / Math (265)

# Career Ready Indicators

Career Cluster Identified and Three or More of the Following Benchmarks:

- 90% Attendance
- 25 hours Community Service
- Work Based Learning Experience
- Industry Credential
- Successful Completion of Dual Credit College Course
- Participated in Two or More Organized Co-Curricular Activities

# Work Based Learning Experience Examples:

- ✚ High School Internship Program (Manufacturing)
  - Paid opportunity [\$11/hour] to work with our manufacturing team at the Governor Road plant facility. Looking for students to work full-time hours (7:30-4:00) during the Summer 2019.
  - Eligible Students: Senior standing
  
- ✚ School to Work Program [Administrative & Drafting]
  - Paid opportunity [\$11/hour] to work with our Drafting or Admin teams. Looking for students to work FT hours during Summer 2019 and part time hours throughout the 2019-2020 school year [this portion we can be flexible but would like to see 10hours/week]– see attached descriptions
  - Eligible Students: Senior classification by August 2019
  
- ✚ STEM Academy
  - This is an [unpaid] 8-day interactive job shadow where students will be exposed to STEM related careers at Emerson.
  - Eligible Students: Junior or Senior standing, **OR** recently graduated students by August 2019

# Regents Admission Index (RAI score)

3 X ACT composite score

+

30 X high school grade point average

+

5 X number of high school core subject courses

= SCORE

Example 1:

$$3 \times 18 + 30 \times 3.2 + 5 \times 13 = 215$$

Automatic admission to state school  $\geq 245$ ,  
this application will be reviewed for admission.

Example 2:

$$3 \times 21 + 30 \times 3.8 + 5 \times 16 = 257$$

Automatic admission to state school  $\geq 245$ ,  
this application will result in automatic admission.

- Accuplacer - Needed for Community Colleges
