



### **Important update from MCSD regarding displaced employees**

The Marshalltown School Board took action during a special meeting on Wednesday, March 18, 2020 to address the situation with displaced hourly district employees amid the COVID-19 crisis. Specifically, the board adopted [a resolution](#) which states the district's hourly employees - including paraeducators, 10-month secretaries, bus drivers, bus monitors and food service employees - will receive their regular pay and benefits contingent upon being available for assignment during this unprecedented school closure, which is currently set to end April 10, 2020. The District will continue to evaluate and adapt to the evolving situation in regards to COVID-19.

District Superintendent Dr. Theron Schutte indicated, "This is the absolute right decision for our valued employees during these extremely difficult and challenging times. I'm confident that we can find safe and meaningful work for our employees during this time of closure in order to keep our District moving in a positive direction."
