2021-22 PK / K REGISTRATION

Children turning 4 on or before September 15, 2021 are eligible to attend 4 year old Preschool.



Registration will take place at the Marshalltown School Central Office building (1002 S. 3rd Ave). The registration window is February 1 - April 1. Please call the Marshalltown School District Central Office at

SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

There is a direct connection between school attendance and student learning. School attendance is first the parent's responsibility. Research states that for each day missed, it takes 3 days to catch up. It is expected that student attendance is at 95% (miss no more than 9 days per year.)



Here is the attendance breakdown by grade and as a building for in person learning through the end of the 3rd quarter.

Preschool - 3yr old -93%	Preschool- 4 yr old - 91 %
Kindergarten- 93 %	1st Grade- 93%
2nd Grade- 95%	3rd Grade- 94 %
4th Grade- 95%	HOGLAN BUILDING- 94%
