



The MCSD **On-Site Learning model** includes students accessing learning in a traditional format in-person. For students who cannot or choose not to attend an on-site learning model, the District will work with families to provide an equivalent online instructional model. In the on-site learning model, the majority of students access their learning on campus. When on campus, students access in-person teaching and learning which incorporates social distancing and enhanced cleaning measures while following the Iowa Department of Education, Centers for Disease Control, and local Marshall County health department safety guidance in all instructional models.

Program Description

When health and safety conditions allow all individuals within our learning community to return to our campuses, we will utilize our on-site learning model with learning access on campus.

- Student work and participation will be required, assessed, and graded.
- When school is in session, attendance is required. Staff and students will be required to wear protective face coverings.
- Social distancing will be practiced, transitions will be limited, and personal protective equipment will be implemented and utilized like desk shields, hand sanitizers, etc.
- Teachers will be provided ongoing professional learning to further develop their skill set as it relates to transitioning from on-site learning to blended learning in a hybrid model.
- Complete implementation of district curriculum and resources.
- All necessary school resources for learning are available each day.
- The district will offer training to families on accessing lessons and supporting learning.

Curriculum, Extracurriculars, and Other Operations

- Engaging, age-appropriate, standards-based lessons utilizing high quality resources.
- Consistent organization and delivery of instruction utilizing the adopted platform.
- Social emotional learning needs are emphasized and embedded into the day.
- Regular and on-going feedback provided to students and parents regarding progress.
- Transportation is provided during this time to eligible students.
- Breakfast and lunch are provided on-site.
- Extracurricular activities will continue if deemed safe by the state associations, local board, etc.
