Auditions February 4, 2019

Dear Parents and Guardians,

The audition for the Missoula Children's Theatre production of ***Snow White & the Seven Dwarfs*** will be held on February 4, 2019 at 4:00 pm at First Presbyterian Church (101 S. Center St). There are roles for those students Kindergarten through 8th grade. Approximately 50-60 local students will be cast to appear in the show with the MCT Tour Actor/Director. **There is no guarantee that everyone who auditions will be cast in the play.** Students wishing to audition must arrive by the scheduled starting time and stay for the entire two-hour session. Students not registering to audition by 4:00 pm will not be allowed to participate. The first rehearsal begins approximately 15-30 minutes after the audition.

This is a group audition – no advance preparation is necessary. Students should just be ready to come and have a good time!

Rehearsals will be conducted daily until performance time. Rehearsals are Monday, February 4 through Thursday, February 7 from 4:00 pm - 8:00 pm at First Presbyterian Church. There will be a dress rehearsal on Friday, February 8 from 4:00 pm – 8:00 pm at the Marshalltown High School auditorium. Although not all cast members will be needed at every session, those auditioning must have a clear schedule for the entire week and if selected, be able to attend all rehearsals required for their role. A detailed rehearsal schedule will be distributed at the conclusion of the audition. Cast members scheduled for the full 4 hours of rehearsal will be asked to bring a sack lunch, dinner or snack.

The performance will be Saturday, February 9 at 1:00 pm at the Marshalltown High School auditorium. All those cast must be available for the scheduled performance.

This coming year more than 65,000 cast members across the globe will take to the stage to the delight and applause of their families, friends, community, neighbors and teachers!
