Policy Title Legal Status of the Board of Directors

Code No. 201.2

The Board of Directors of Marshalltown Community School District derives its legal status from the Constitution of the State of Iowa and the statutes enacted by the General Assembly. Since the Board of Directors acts as an agent of the state in developing an educational program in accordance with the Constitution and laws of the State of Iowa, it is subject to the restrictions of the legislature and such agencies as are designated by the legislature.

The policy of the State from early times has been to establish a board elected directly by the people, separate from other governing boards and to place the control of the public schools within the jurisdiction of that body unhampered as to details of administration and not subject to review of any other board as to acts performed in good faith.
