Policy Title Organization of the Board

Code No. 201.7

The Board will hold an annual meeting for the purpose of electing officers. In odd-numbered years, the annual meeting of the Marshalltown Community School District Board of Directors shall be followed by an organizational meeting of the Board. The organizational meeting shall be held at the next regular Board meeting following the regular school election. The purpose of the meeting shall be to seat new Board members. At the annual meeting, the Board will elect a president and vice president to hold office for a term of one year. These elections may be by written ballot without nomination, and the Board member receiving a majority of the votes cast for each office shall be declared elected. If, however, more than one board member is nominated on the first ballot, there will be a runoff until there are no more than two candidates. The candidate winning the majority of votes on the final ballot will take the office. To comply with the Open Meetings Law, each member's ballot will be identified.
