The President of the Board of Directors shall preside at all of its meetings, sign warrants and drafts, and all orders drawn upon the Treasurer as provided by law, sign all contracts made by the Board, and appear in behalf of this corporation in all actions brought by or against it, unless individually a party, in which case this duty shall be performed by the Secretary.

In addition thereto, the President shall exercise such powers as may be delegated by the Board, appoint special and standing committees, and shall act for the Board of Directors in emergencies requiring action before the Board of Education can be assembled. Such action must be reported at the next regular meeting of the Board.

The President is an ex-officio member of all committees.

The Vice-President shall serve in the absence of the President.

In the absence of the President or Vice-President, the Board shall elect a President Pro Tem.
