Policy Title: Student School Board Representatives Regulation

Code No. 202.6-R

Job Description:

The Marshalltown Community School District Student School Board Representatives play a non-voting role on the School Board. Their primary responsibility is to represent the voice of Marshalltown students on issues and policies that directly affect the student body by playing an active role in Board discussions.

Requirements:

- Must have a 2.75 GPA or higher and no failing grades
- Must attend Marshalltown High School or Marshalltown Learning Academy
- Must be a sophomore, junior or senior
- Must not have any major in or out of school disciplinary issues (including Code of Conduct violations)
- Must be able to attend all (most) open School Board meetings (1st & 3rd Mondays @ 5:00 p.m.) from the beginning of September through the end of May.

Student Must Demonstrate:

- Leadership skills and experience
- Communication skills (both written and verbal)

- Listening skills
- Time management
- Is open-minded to opinions that differ from their own
- Respect for the student-teacher-principal relationship
