Policy Title Organizational Meeting

Code No. 204.5

In odd-numbered years, a meeting for organization of the Marshalltown Community School District Board of Directors will be held at the next regular meeting following the official school election canvass. The Board shall be called to order by the board secretary.

The purpose of the meeting is to transfer material and responsibility from the retiring Board to the new Board.

The organizational meeting of the Board will be held in two parts: the final meeting of the retiring Board, and the organizational meeting of the new Board.

The first order of business of the new Board shall be to swear into office any new members unless they shall have been so sworn previously. The Board shall then elect from its membership a president and vice-president (see 201.7.)

Since there is no new Board to seat in even-numbered years, there is no requirement for an Organizational Meeting in those years.
