Policy Title Statement of Guiding Principles for Administration

Code No. 300

Marshalltown Community School District administrators share the responsibility to provide educational leadership and implement the educational philosophy of the district. Additionally, administrators throughout the district oversee employees, monitor educational issues confronting the school district, and inform the board about district operations. In carrying out these responsibilities, the administrators are guided by board policy, the law, the needs of students, and the wishes of the citizens of the Marshalltown Community School District.

While the board holds the superintendent ultimately responsible for these duties, the principals are more directly responsible for educational results, the administration of the school facilities, and supervision of building employees.

The board and administration will work together to share information and decisions in a collaborative manner.
