Policy Title Role of School District Administration

Code No. 300

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School district administrators have been given a great opportunity and responsibility to manage the school district, to provide educational leadership, and to implement the educational philosophy of the school district. They are responsible for the day-to-day operations of the school district. In carrying out these operations, the administrators are guided by board policies, the law, the needs of the students, and the wishes of the citizens in the school district community.

While the board holds the superintendent ultimately responsible for these duties, the principals are more directly responsible for educational results, the administration of the school facilities, and supervision of building employees.

The board and administration will work together to share information and decisions in a collaborative manner.
