Policy Title Building Principals and Associates

All Principal and Associate Principal candidates shall have earned a minimum of the appropriate Master's Degree from an accredited college or university. They must have a major, at the graduate or undergraduate level in the area of service, and hold a valid administrators license and evaluator approval certification from the Iowa Department of Education.

Elementary and secondary school principals and associates shall be appointed by the Board of Directors upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools for initial contracts of one year. After serving at least nine months a principal or associate may annually be employed for a term of two years.

In order to assist Building Principals in carrying out the responsibilities of their offices, the Board may elect, as need is established, one or more Associate Principals, each of whom shall perform such duties as may from time to time be assigned to him or her by the Principal.
