Policy Title Administrative/Management Team

Code No. 310.1

The Marshalltown Community School District will function under an Administrative/Management Team concept, with board members and the administrators working together to make decisions and set goals for the school district. This effort is designed to obtain, share, and use information to operate an effective educational system; to make equitable and democratic decisions, and formulate comprehensive school district policies and regulations.

It is the responsibility of the superintendent to develop guidelines for cooperative decision-making as well as organizational procedures that ensure involvement of staff members. Each administrator is expected to fully participate in the management of the school district by investigating, analyzing, and expressing their views on issues. Those board members or administrators with special expertise or knowledge of an issue may be called upon to provide information. All administrative decisions must be guided by sound practices that benefit students served.

The board is responsible for making the final decision in matters pertaining to the school district. Each board member and administrator will support the decisions reached.
