Policy Title: Attendance Center Assignment

Code No. 501.5

The board will have complete discretion to determine the boundaries for each attendance center. It is the responsibility of the superintendent or designee to assign student to the attendance centers, and to assign students to classrooms within the attendance center.

The superintendent will consider the geographical layout of the school district, the condition and location of the school district facilities, the location of student population, possible transportation difficulties, financial condition of the school district and other factors deemed relevant by the superintendent or the board when making attendance center assignments.

Pupils shall be required to attend their assigned attendance center but the superintendent or his/her staff, for good cause, may transfer a pupil to another attendance center. Pupils moving to another attendance center during the last quarter of the school year may remain in their former attendance center until the end of the school year upon request by the parent or guardian and approval by the Superintendent of Schools.
