Policy Title : Life Threatening Allergies

Code No. 507.12

The Marshalltown Community School District understands the prevalence of life threatening allergies among school populations and proactively endorses the concept of being allergy aware and will maintain a system-wide emergency plan for addressing life threatening allergic reactions. Marshalltown Community School District is committed to working in cooperation with parents, students, and physicians, to minimize risks and provide a safe educational environment for all students, however, cannot guarantee that the student will never be exposed to irritants and/or allergens. The District will utilize procedures to minimize the chance of a child experiencing a life threatening allergic reaction on campus during the school day. It is the parent's/guardian's responsibility to notify the building principal or nurse of student(s) who have life threatening allergies. It is the parent's/guardian's responsibility to supply the school with Epinephrine injections if prescribed for their child. Any student who has written medical documentation regarding a potentially life threatening allergy will have an individual Emergency Health Plan (EHP).
