Policy Title: Physical Education

Students in grades one through twelve are required to participate in physical education courses unless they are excused by the principal of their attendance center.

Students may be excused from physical education courses if the student presents a written statement from a doctor stating that such activities could be injurious to the health of the student or the student has been exempted because of a conflict with the student's religious beliefs.

In order for students in grades 9-12 to complete academic course work not otherwise available to them, the Marshalltown Community School District's Board of Directors, in accordance with Iowa Administrative Code 256.11.5.g, authorizes the following:

All students in grades 9-12 are required to complete one (1) semester of physical education course work per academic year. This course will meet daily for one class period and earn .5 credit per semester.

Students who will not participate in physical education must have a written request or statement from their parents.
