Policy Title: Foreign Students

Qualified foreign students may be enrolled and attend school without charge if they meet all district entrance requirements including age, place of residence and immunization. Foreign students must be approved by the board. The administration reserves the right to limit the number of foreign students accepted. Students who are citizens of a foreign country will be considered residents if they meet one of the following requirements:

- The student resides with his/her parents(s) or legal guardian within the boundaries of this district.
- The student is in the United States with appropriate documentation (Form I-20) from the United States Department of Justice-Immigration and Naturalization Services; or
- The student is a participant in a recognized foreign exchange program (such as American Field Service, Youth for Understanding, or an approved local organization) and,
- The student is physically able to attend school and has provided the school district with such proof, including a current TB test.
