Policy Title: Purpose and Scope of Child Nutrition Programs

Code No. 710.1

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The Marshalltown Community School District Board of Education agrees to participate in the National School Lunch Program and School Breakfast Program in all attendance centers. Additional programs approved for participation as eligible for each building include: the Fruit and Vegetable Program, After School Snack Program, Summer Food Service Program and receiving of commodities donated by the USDA.

School food service facilities are provided to serve students and staff when school is in session and during school-related activities. Facilities may also be used under the supervision of the Food and Nutrition Service Director and his/her designees for providing food service in accordance with board policy to: community stakeholders/groups, school personnel groups, parent-teacher meetings, or civic organization meetings for the purpose of better understanding the schools.

Child Nutrition Programs shall be under the direction of the Director of Food and Nutrition Services who will establish and maintain a central record system; be responsible for accurate provision of meal benefits; prepare menus and recipes; develop standards; initiate purchasing; recommend personnel for employment; promotion or dismissal; and conduct departmental training.

The Child Nutrition Programs shall provide nutritious and balanced meals to the students

which incorporate a variety of foods in moderate portions and meet nutrition standards as set by the USDA for the programs listed above.
