Policy Title: Site Acquisition

Code No. 801.4

It is the responsibility of the superintendent to assist the board and to make recommendations concerning the acquisition of sites.

The administration may request the assistance of the School District architect, a real estate committee, the zoning commission, and any other urban planning organization in making the site acquisition recommendation.

Elementary schools shall be, insofar as possible, centered within natural residential areas and located so that children do not have to cross main traffic arteries and railroads.

Sites acquired by the board will meet or, upon improvement, be able to meet the specifications set out by the board prior to using the site for the education program. The board may meet in closed session to discuss potential purchases of sites.

All provisions as specified by the Code of Iowa shall be followed in site negotiations and acquisition.
